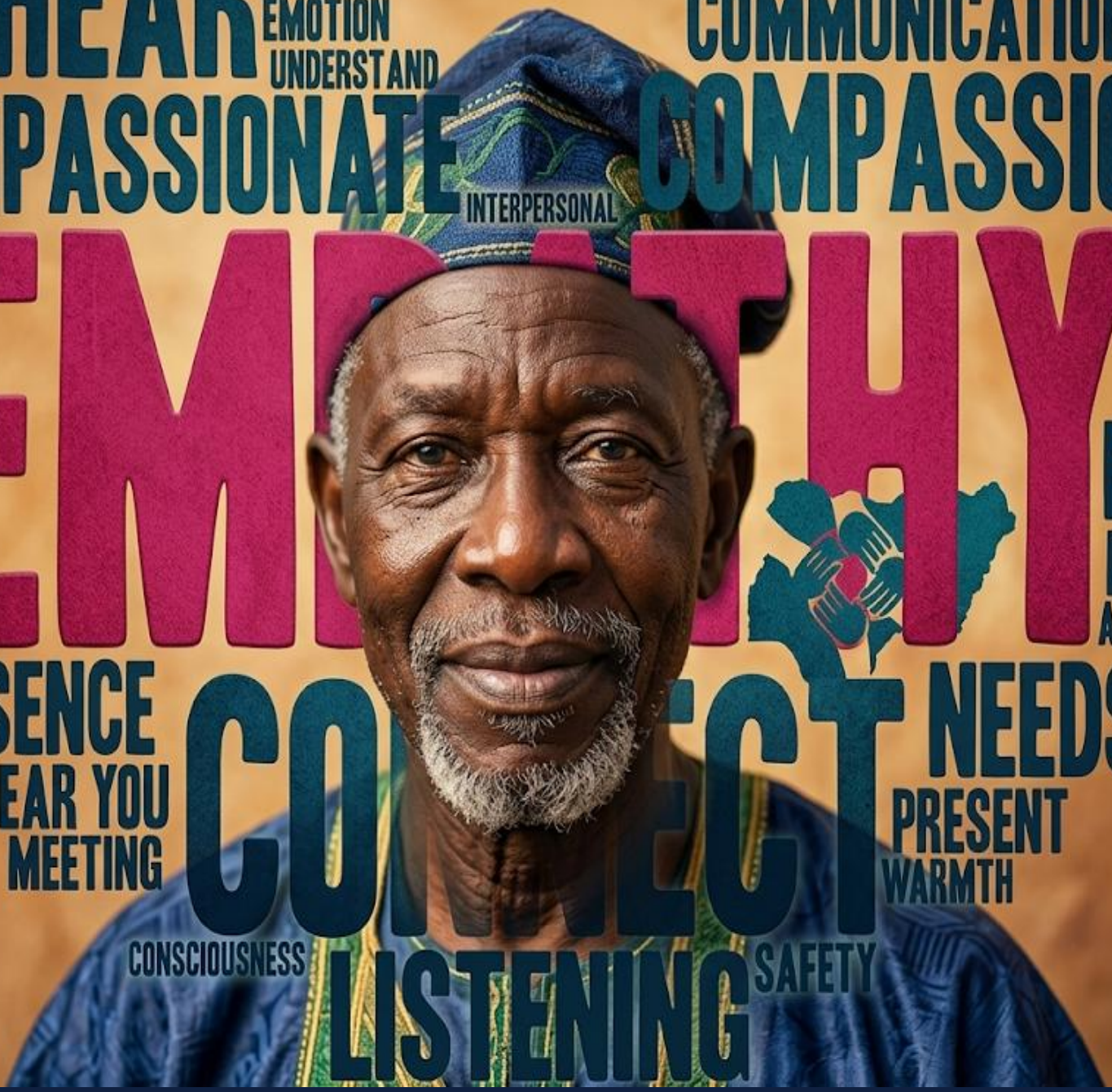

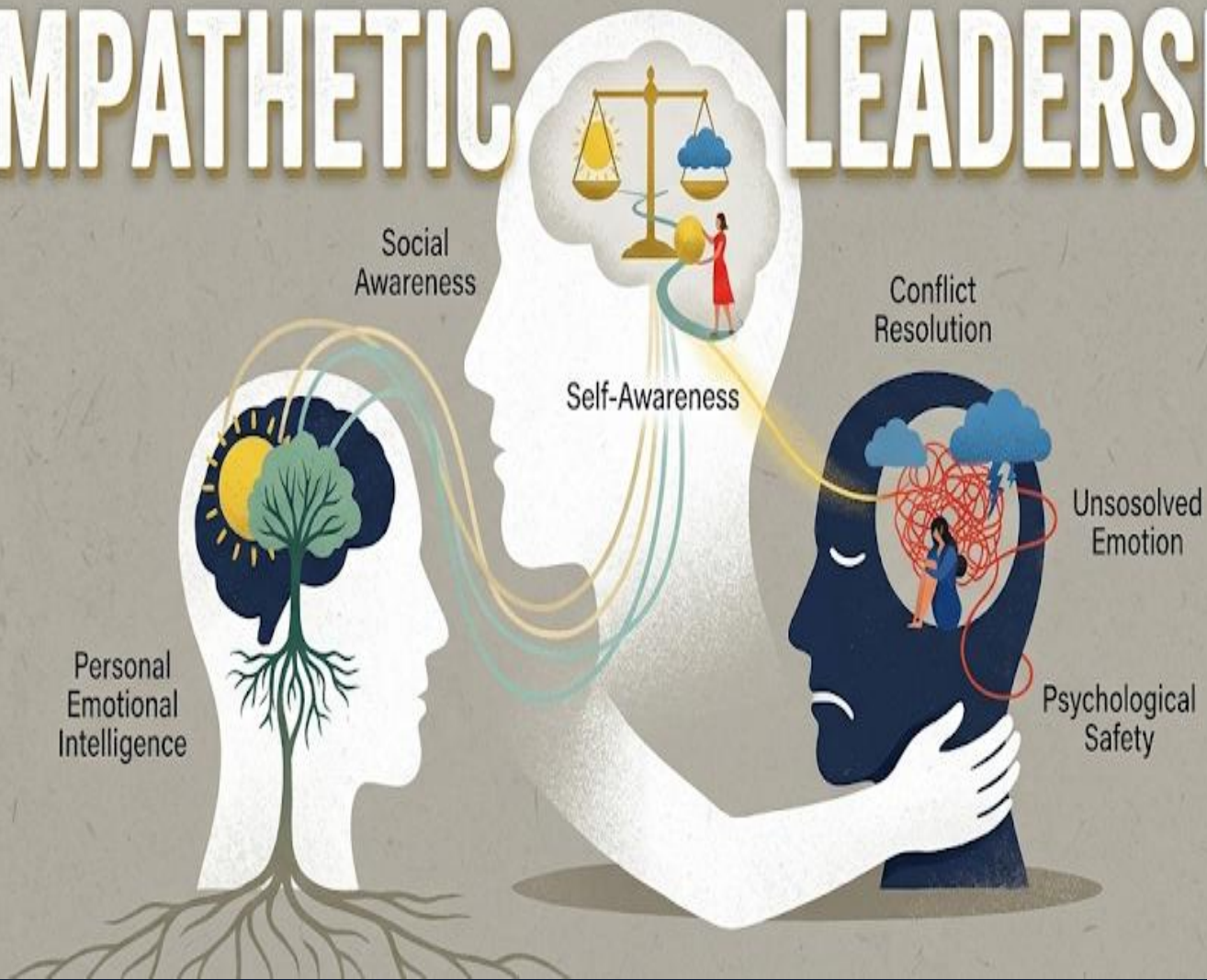


The Psychology of Empathetic Leadership

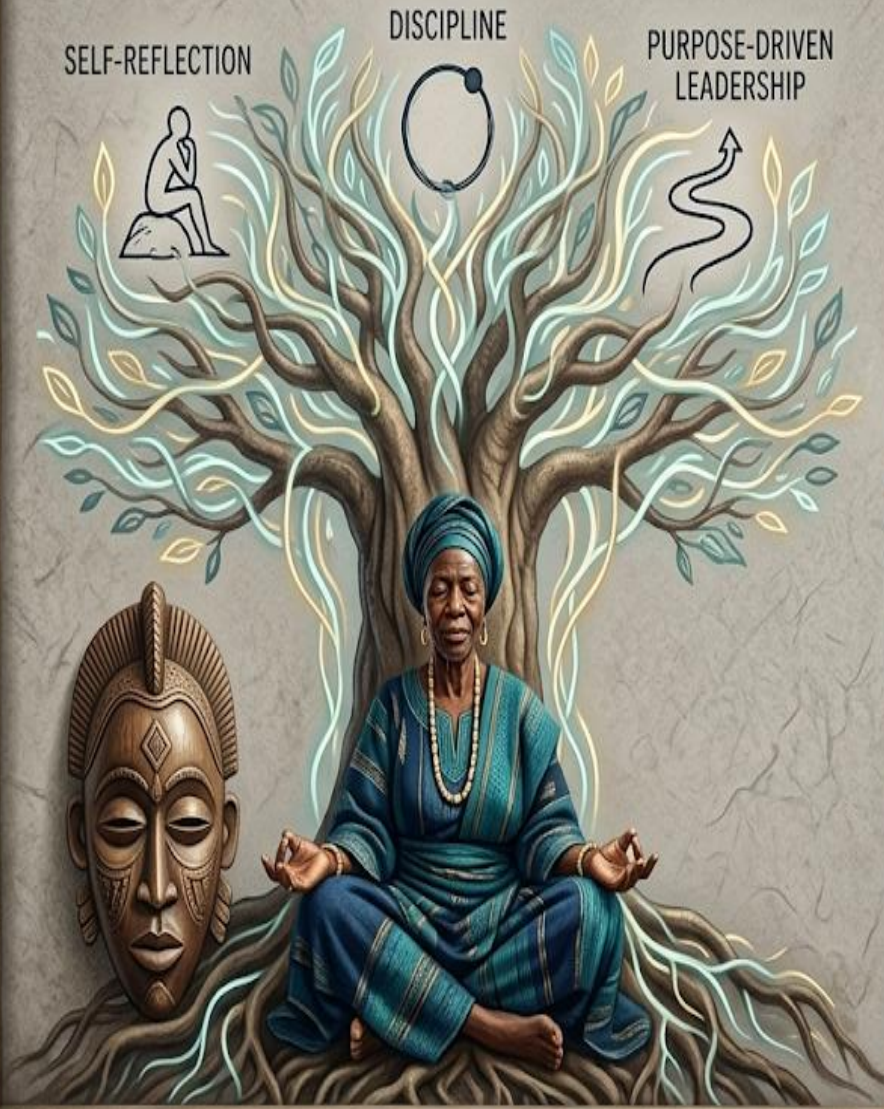

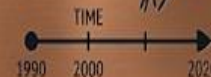

Daily habits strengthen emotional endurance.

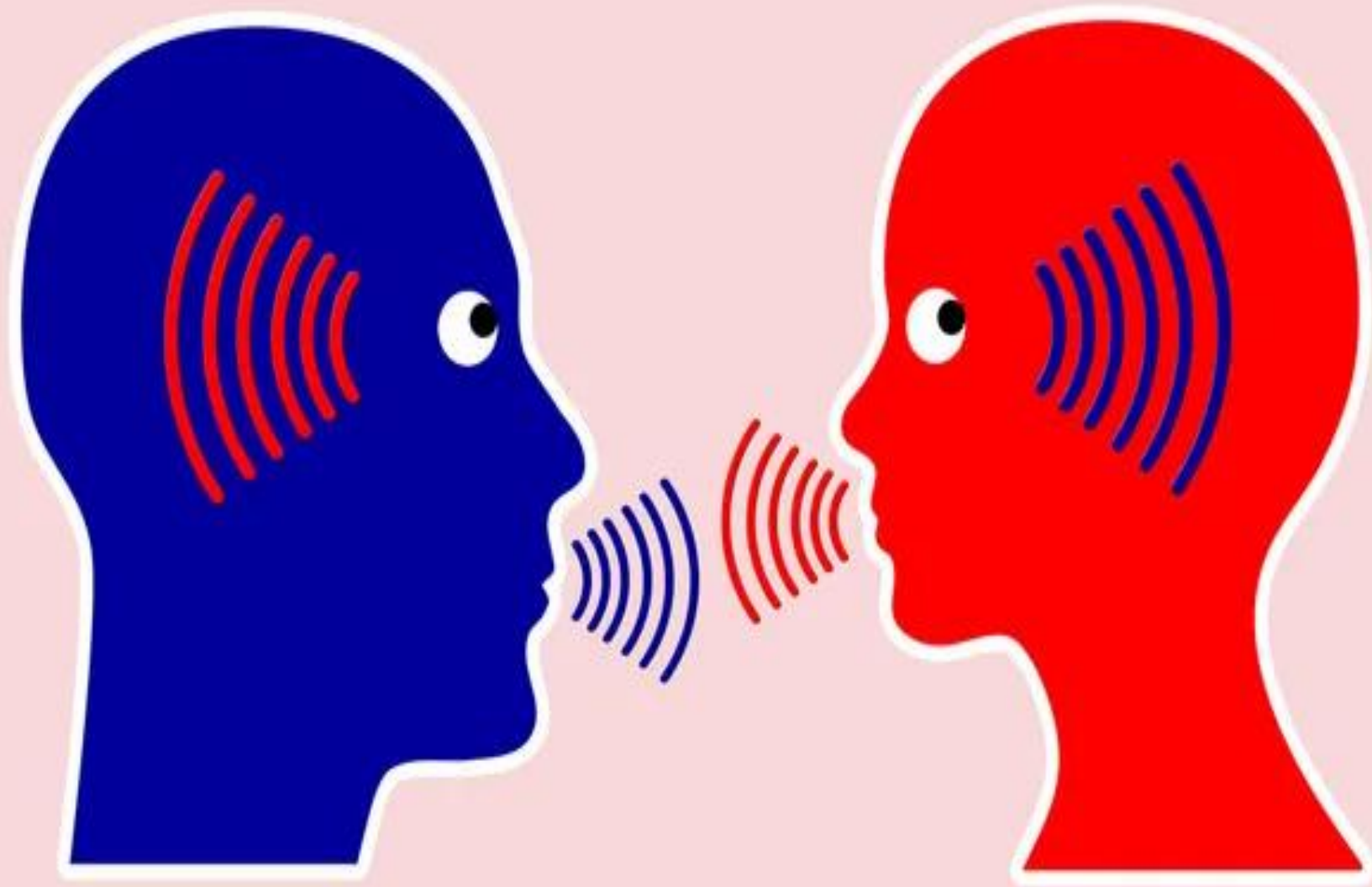
1. Mindfulness
